5. Workshop for handloom weaving for fabric development

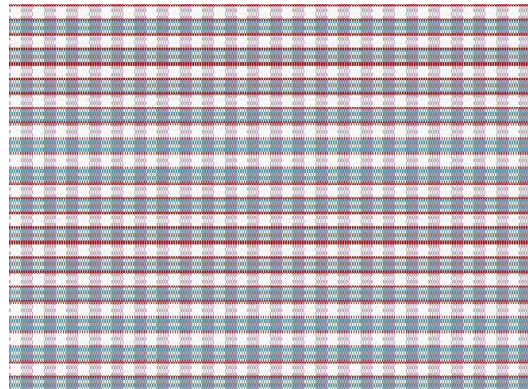

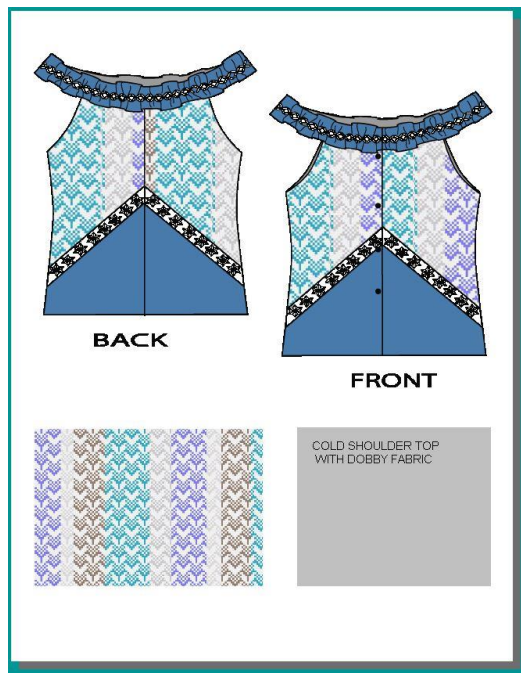


6. Workshop on Computer-Aided Textile Design by Tuka Tech Inc.
